The Lady Warriors cruised to their 4<sup>th</sup> straight ACAA title while challenging themselves in their non-conference schedule and posted a 15-4-1 record. The girls JV (5-1) and Junior High (8-0) teams had a great season as the coaches put in significant effort to build relationship and to develop players for the future. The boys program continued to grow with 24 boys participating in high school and another 29 boys participating in Junior High. The boys varsity had the most challenging non-conference schedule in its history, which included winning a tournament against PIAA class 2A schools and competing against all of the top teams in PIAA district 4 class A. The team rose to the challenge and recorded an impressive 18-4 record. The JV (6-2) and Junior High (9-4-2) teams continued in their goal to build for the future, including a win for the Junior High at the JCS tournament. Most importantly, the teams sought to bring glory to God through their play; and the way the older players continue to support, encourage and develop relationships with younger players all the way down to 5<sup>th</sup> grade is what sets the program apart.

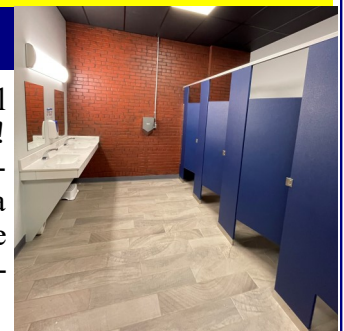
# Help Wanted!
