Principal's Desk

Dear NCS Parents,

I wanted use my section of the newsletter this month to let you know about an addition to our high school Bible class that I'm extremely excited about!

You only need to turn on the news, check your social media, or go to the grocery store to understand that our world is not only becoming more chaotic and self-centered, but is desperately depraved and completely swallowing the lie that people just need to look inside themselves, discover what truth they want to believe, and spend their lives pursuing that at the expense of everyone and everything the Bible would point them towards.

One of my favorite aspects of an NCS education has always been the intense Scripture memorization foundation that our students experience. Over the course of the past couple years, and especially during the first half of this year, the Lord has continuously laid on our hearts the thought of how to allow our older students to have a more open dialogue regarding how the truth of Scripture fits practically into the modern-day problems that they regularly encounter. What DOES the Bible say about my friend who is struggling with addiction or my family member who battles depression? How can the truth of God's Word affect the time I spend on social media and what I do/say with what I see there?

In Ephesians 1:16-19 Paul says, *"I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers, that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of Glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him, having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe, according to the working of his great might."* God works through the truth of His Word and the power of the gospel to enlighten our hearts to the glorious inheritance of HIM!! He is our inheritance if we know Him! We want our students to really know Christ and to be bold and thoughtful in the pursuit of overlaying the truth of God's Word upon the daily challenging circumstances in their own lives and the lives of those around them. We hope, moving forward, to focus on a variety of topics that are directly impacting our students on a daily basis.

Our first two sessions have gone well and I am greatly encouraged by the participation, questions, and discussion that students are engaging in. Please pray with us for the future of this endeavor. May the Lord add His blessing to these times, and may we truly have impact on our students for the glory of God!
