2 Samuel 23:11-12

And next to him was Shammah, the son of Agee the Hararite. The Philistines gathered together at Lehi, where there was a plot of ground full of lentils, and the men fled from the Philistines. But he took his stand in the midst of the plot and defended it and struck down the Philistines, and the Lord worked a great victory!

Isn't it interesting that in 2 Samuel 23, as David's Mighty Men are being described, that the phrase, "And the Lord worked a great victory," keeps coming up? All of the other soldiers had fled, and Shammah took his stand in the middle of a field of lentils. He won a great battle, defeating countless Philistine soldiers, but the author of this passage does not point to Shammah and give him the credit. Instead, he gives glory where it is due. "The Lord worked a great victory!"

What a joy it has been to watch our girls and boys basketball teams compete this season! Our girls team made history by bringing home the first ever PIAA 1A State Championship trophy to NCS. This was the crowning achievement of a season of numerous achievements including winning the Upper Dauphin Tip-Off Tournament, Warrior Run Holiday Tournament, a 6th straight ACAA regular season and tournament championship, and finishing with a final season record of 27-3. Our boys team claimed their 5th straight ACAA tournament as well as a 3rd place finish in District IV, and a state playoff game against Lancaster Country Day, finishing with a regular season record of 25-6.

It has been a blessing to watch our athletes, coaches, families and fans praise the Lord for working these victories throughout the season. Regardless of what we find to do in our lives as Christians, all glory should go to God. We praise Him and Him alone for the talents, abilities, and interests that He has given to our students. We look to Him to work in their lives, first for salvation, and then for His sanctifying work to be done in their lives through whatever His will is for them to do. May Jesus Christ be praised!
