## Principal's Desk

#### Ephesians 2:8-9

For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is a gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.

This past week I had the privilege of attending the Together for the Gospel Conference in Louisville, Kentucky. Between the gospel-centered preaching, the amazing singing, the massive bookstore of solid, biblical resources and the sweet fellowship with fellow elders, our wives, and other school leaders, it was like drinking from a spiritual fire hose. Just when you thought you couldn't fathom one more amazing truth about who God is and what He has done for us through His Son, Jesus Christ, there would be another sermon, song, or conversation to amaze you at God's sovereign beauty and goodness. With all of the incredibly gifted pastors present it would be impossible to choose a favorite, however I wanted to share an analogy that was used by Kevin DeYoung in his sermon on justification that was a huge encouragement to me personally.

One of the points that Kevin made was, as believers, we can "lay down on the bed of Jesus Christ, the object of our faith." He then used this example to speak about the difference between faith and the object of faith. When he was younger and living up north, Kevin and his friends would go to the local pond to play hockey. In order to determine if the ice would hold they would throw stones out on the ice to see if it would break. If it held they would throw bigger rocks until, eventually, the lightest boy would be coaxed to go out and test the ice to see if it held. His point was that he and his friends might have had faith that the ice would hold, but the bottom line is, if the ice wasn't thick and reliable, it didn't matter. We can have faith in many things, but it is the object of our faith that is important. "It's not your faith level, but the thickness of the ice you are believing in." Praise God both for giving us faith to believe and also for being the perfect, righteous object of our faith in which there is total security and assurance. Faith in Jesus Christ is different than faith in any other person, place, or thing in existence. Not because of the faith, but because of who HE is.

As the end of the school year approaches, we reflect on our faithful, perfect God. He has showered NCS with grace and mercy these past 50 years, and we praise Him and Him alone for all that has been or will be accomplished through our school. May we never take our eyes off of Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith.
