## Principal's Desk

#### Psalm 119: 25-32

25 My soul clings to the dust; give me life according to your word! 26 When I told of my ways, you answered me; teach me your statutes! 27 Make me understand the way of your precepts, and I will meditate on your wondrous works. 28 My soul melts away for sorrow; strengthen me according to your word! 29 Put false ways far from me and graciously teach me your law! 30 I have chosen the way of faithfulness; I set vour rules before me. 31 I cling to your testimonies, O Lord; let me not be put to shame! 32 I will run in the way of your commandments when you enlarge my heart!

Over the past month, Pastor Bob Gray has graciously led the chapel devotion here at NCS. For several weeks we were in different parts of Psalm 119, including the passage above. Being in education for many years, one of the interesting things that has stuck out to me is the fact that the third marking period of the school year often seems to be the toughest of the year. Between the long, dark days of winter, increased academic rigor, late-night sports and travel, and homework, things can get pretty dreary.

Often we might feel like our soul is "clinging to the dust" during these challenging times in our lives. The Psalmist uses other phrases like, "my soul melts away for sorrow" and "strengthen me" as he writes. There are a couple of thoughts I'd like to point out to us regarding this passage: First, the life, understanding, strength, teaching that the Psalmist asks for all come from outside himself. He does not say, "My soul clings to the dust, so I work harder at trying to handle life on my own." Instead he says, "Give me life, according to Your Word."

Our soul clings to the dust because of sin, and Jesus made it possible for you and me to have life, first through His perfect life, death, and resurrection from the dead in our place. Second, through His revealed Word to us and through prayer. Feeling down and overwhelmed? Talk to the Creator of the Universe who knows all things and sacrificed His only Son for you. Run down and depressed? Read the Word of God for strength and encouragement. The Psalmist does not look inside himself for answers, he looks to God and God's Word, "give me life according to Your Word," "Teach me your statutes," "Teach me your law," "I set your rules before me," "I cling to your testimonies." We can only "run in the way of His commandments" when it is He who "enlarges our heart."

May the Lord enlarge our hearts to run hard after Him! Sunshine is coming, learning is happening, times of rest and refreshment will come from the Lord. Let's look to Him to give us life according to His word!

**THANK YOU** to all of you who supported NCS in 2021 through your prayers, volunteer efforts, and financial gifts! Your partnership in each of these areas is so vital to this ministry. Financially, there are two main areas in which we are in continual need of your support.

<u>The NCS Annual Fund:</u> The NCS Annual Fund supplements tuition in covering the cost of educating students at NCS. As the Lord allows us to reach our goal, we are able to avoid large increases in tuition prices. The level of contributions as of February 1, 2022, has propelled us past the halfway mark towards meeting our NCS Annual Fund goal for this school year. Please review the following information and join us in praying that the Lord would work through His people to meet this need.

NCS Annual Fund Goal:	\$250,000
Current Level:	\$144,251
Remaining Deficit: (needed by May 31, 2022)	\$105,749

<u>Scholarships/Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) Program:</u> Many families rely on scholarships to be able to afford to send their children to NCS. The EITC program has been a tremendous blessing in recent years, providing several hundred thousand dollars in support to NCS families.

The EITC tax credit program allows businesses and individuals to give life-changing scholarship funds to students and receive up to a 90% tax credit from the state. Any business based in PA is eligible. Also, individuals who pay \$3,500 or more in PA taxes a year can now participate.
